## Tap your Finch/Nyjer tube to prevent seed “bridging”

*Seed cavities occur when the air is humid. The dampness allows the seed to cling together and will form a cavity when birds select through the portal. We call this “bridging”. Tap your feeder every time you pass by and at minimum every week.*



### Symptom:

The feeder looks full but no finches are visiting.

### Solution:

Tap the side of your feeder to settle the seed.

### Frequency:

Tap your feeder every time you pass the feeder or at least once per week.



## Tap your tube!



Out of reach seed cavity



Simply tap the side of your feeder and the cavity will collapse so the seed is within easy reach.

Seed will drop and refill the space
